### SATURDAY, MARCH 3

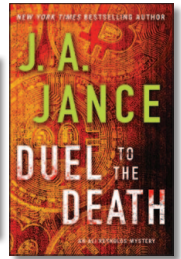
**11 am • Children’s Story Time** • The first 15 minutes will be storytelling for younger children, a longer story for children ages 3-7 will follow.

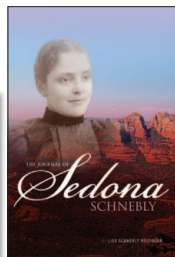

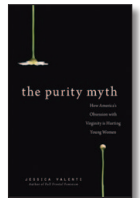

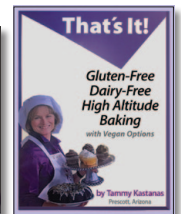
